Natural Cellular Defense

February 2, 2005 I had a Heavy Metals Profile done by Dr. Glen Wilcoxson in Mobile, AL. I immediately started a program to reduce the aluminum in my body. Between February 2, 2005 and April 7, 2005 I took four (4) IV infusions of EDTA, eight (8) injections of desferal and 100mg of DMSA every other night. The desferal shots were \$100.00 each and the EDTA IV infusions were \$125.00 each from Dr. Ward Dean and Dr. Glen Wilcoxson. The DMSA was taken for mercury even though none was detected. After spending \$1,300.00 for treatment plus driving to Mobile, AL every week, 296 miles round trip, and missing a day of work a week for over two (2) months the end result was a drop in aluminum from fifty (50) to forty-eight (48). That's only two (2) points!

Nothing was taken after April 7, 2005 due to my schedule and numerous trips to lecture and study around the country until October 2005. I was then introduced to Natural Cellular Defense (NCD) by Dr. Linda Freeland and signed up as a distributor and started taking NCD on October 26, 2005. First week five (5) drops on tongue after a large glass of water. Week two (2) ten (10) drops three (3) times a day and continued this until present date.

There were periods of light nausea and also intermittent strong urine and feces smells until the end of December 2005. The smell gradually returned to normal of both urine and feces by early January 2006.

On November 7, 2005 I got an IV infusion of Natural Cellular Defense in Mobile, AL. We were not expecting the urine smell to be so overpowering and did not collect urine for testing purposes. The IV infusion consisted of thirty (30) drops of NCD in a 250cc bag of normal saline dripped over 75 minutes. Blood pressure was checked several times that day and remained at 130/76.

On January 4, 2006 I returned to Mobile, AL to visit Dr. Glen Wilcoxson and work with several of his patients who have Hepatitis C and Alzheimers Disease. While there I decided to get another IV infusion of NCD. Sixty (60) drops in a 250cc bag of normal saline solution infused in one (1) hour. No side effects were noted during or after the infusion. Urine was collected for twenty-four (24) hours and sent to LabCorp for testing. The lab reports are attached hereto since no one would believe the aluminum level went down to TEN (10)!!! I have attached reports hereto.

I will continue taking NCD at thirty (30) drops a day for another three (3) months and retest via IV infusion again using sixty (60) drops of NCD as per test on January 4, 2006.

Additionally, I have started taking 1,500 mg a day of magnesium malate for the additional arsenic that I would like removed from my body.

I have sent out over 200 packages of information on Natural Cellular Defense along with a CD. If someone is sitting on the fence waiting for more proof the attached lab reports along with 1,600 studies of Zeolite found on Pubmed should be enough for anyone.

Most of you know that there are two (2) ways to purchase the product. Retail or sign up as a distributor and purchase a minimum of four (4) bottles a month and stay on autoship.

I have every patient on NCD that can afford the product because it works better than any detox I have ever taken or that the patient could ever find. The NCD is totally compatible with all of my mild silver protein products and even when mixed do not cancel each other out. However, to prevent a herxheimer reaction, take NCD thirty (30) minutes apart from any of my MSP products.

I have worked with D.V.M.s who have used the NCD and Silver 400 on twelve (12) to thirteen (13) year old cats with tumors some as large as 2" x 3 1/2". All cats are alive and well as of this writing. The package of information that I am currently sending out on NCD is over 120 pages and growing.
